A Clinical Study of 'Bilva Patra Kwath Avagahan Sweda' in Management of Arsha in Garbhini w.s.r. to Haemorrhoids

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An uncomfortable, painful condition that is very common during pregnancy is Haemorrhoids. Due to various causes the haemorrhoidal plexus get dilated and inflamed resulting in formation of haemorrhoids which if not treated at proper time causes profuse bleeding and protrusion of the haemorrhoids. In such a condition, surgical and para-surgical procedures have limitations and use of internal ushna and tikshna kalpas are contraindicated in Garbhini. Keeping these problems in view Bilva patra kwatha avagahana sweda karma in Charaka chikitsa sthana 14/47 was selected to evaluate the effect of avgahana sweda karma in relieving the signs and symptoms of haemorrhoids. Bilva patra kwatha sitz bath given to the Garbhini patient suffering by haemorrhoids.

In the present study, done on 10 patients, an effort has been made to derive safe, easy accessible treatment in pregnancy. Bilva patra kwatha avgahana sweda, which has proven anti-inflammatory property relieves venous congestion, relieves spasm of sphincter muscles, reducing irritation and itching. Assessment done on the basis of criteria, resulted in relieving pain and significant reduction in size of pile mass without any untoward side effect in pregnancy.

Pregnancy is such delicate a condition that Acharya Charaka has compared it with handling open container full of oil, so oil should not split out. Haemorrhoids are common during such a delicate condition of pregnancy because of following reasons.

The growing uterus puts pressure on the pelvic veins and inferior vena cava, which can slow the return of blood from the lower half of the body and increase the pressure on the veins, which makes them more dilated or swollen. Also increased progesterone hormone during pregnancy causes vein walls to relax and swell more easily. Progesterone also contributes to constipation by slowing down intestinal tract. Constipation can also cause and

aggravate haemorrhoids due to straining.

In pregnancy surgical and para-surgical procedures have limitations and use of internally ushna and tikshna kalpas are contraindicated which can be harmful for the life, growth and normal development of the fetus. In Ayurveda avagaha sweda is the procedure to sit in warm water for a short period of time, which promotes healing and eases discomfort by encouraging blood flow to the rectal area. It also helps to relax the anal sphincter. Bilva patra kwatha is used for avagaha sweda. Bilva is included in Shothhara and Arshohara Mahakashaya by Acharya Charaka. Bilva leaves anti-inflammatory and analgesic properties and is proved in many recent studies. Also Acharya Charaka has mentioned Bilva patra kwatha avgahana in asrhoroga chikitsa adhyaya.

Aims and Objectives -

- 1) To study the clinical effect of Bilva Patra Kwatha avagah sweda in the Management of Arsha in Garbhini w.s.r. Haemorrhoids.
- 2) To manage and reduce symptoms of Haemorrhoids such as bleeding per rectum. pain, swelling, etc. in Garbhini patients
- 3) To find out simple, able, safe and cost effective therapeutic regimes without any untoward side effect in pregnancy in the management of Rakta Arshas.
- 4) To review the literature about Bilva properties and Arsha vyadhi in Garbhini.

Bilva -

Latin name - Aegle marmelos.

English name - Bael, Bengal quince, Golden apple, Wood apple, Stone apple.

Sanskrit names - Bilva, Shandilya, Shailush, Shreefal, Gandhgarbh, Kantaki, Sadafal, Mahakapittha, Malur, Granthil.

Gana- Shothhara, Arshoghna, Aasthapanoga, Anuvasanopaga (Charaka samhita).

Brihat panchamula, Varunadi gana, Ambshthadi gana.

Ayurvedic properties - • Guna - Laghu, Ruksha • Ras - Kashay, Tikta • Vipak - Katu • Virya - Ushna Doshghnata - Kapha-Vataghna.



Property of Patra (leaves) - Locally Shothhara and Vednasthapana

Parts used - Roots, root bark, leaves, ripe and unripe fruits.

Chemical composition -

Fruit: contains marmalosin,

Young bark: coumarin and umbelliferone,

Matured bark: Y-fragrine, umbelliferone, marmesin, strerols, tritepenoids.

<u>Seeds:</u> aromatic, yellowish greenish oil obtained by pressing, which has laxative effect.

Leaves: contains essential oil consisting of B-phellandrine. Roots, leaves and bark mainly contain tannin.

Recent studies - Following studies shows the anti inflammatory and analgesic property of Aegle marmelos leaves and root extracts -

Materials and Methods -

No. of Patients - 10

Selection of patients - Diagnosed patients of Haemorrhoids in pregnancy at Hospitals O.P.D. and I.P.D. Consent - A well informed written consent has been taken before starting the treatment.

Insrtuments - electric heating instrument, plastic tub for sitting

Drug - Bilva patra kwatha.

Kwatha preparation: 1) Fresh crushed leaves of Bilva boiled in 8 times water upto ¼ of total water remains.

Avagahana Swedan procedure - 1) patient is asked to sit in tub filled with luke warm bilva kwatha for 10 minutes 2) Avgahana sweda given twice a day.

Diet - Pathyapathya advised as follows.

- a) Pathya Ahara Buttermilk, Ghee, milk, Rice, Leafy Vegetables, Citrus Fruits and Plenty of Oral Fluids.
- b) Apathya Ahara Nonv-egeterian food, Spicy Food, Alcohol, Tobacco and Unwholesome preserved canned food.
- c) Apathya Vihara straining during defeacation, in utkatasana.

- d) Duration of Treatment Avagahan sweda given to a day for 7 days
- e) Follow up Twice weekly for 1 month and patie assessed for clinical symptoms on alternate days
- f) Criteria of selection of patients The patients of Gart having classical signs and symptoms of Arsha be selec

Inclusion criteria -

- 1) 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} Degree Haemorrhoids.
- 2) the patient of all trimesters of pregnancy
- 3) Patients of age group 18 to 35 years old.

Exclusion criteria -

- 1) 4th degree Haemorrhoids.
- 2) Thrombosed Haemorrhoids, Haemorrhoids vulcerative colitis, Fissure, Fistula, Rectal-Polyps, Soli Rectal Ulcer and Prolapse of rectum.
- 3) HIV, HBsAg Positive Patients.
- 4) Threatened or any complicated pregnancy, where tl is mother or foetus are at risk.
- 5) Patients with Hepatic Disorders, Diabetes, Pulmor and Intestinal Tuberculosis, Carcinomatous condition Anorectal region and Syphilis.

Investigations -

Routine investigations before treatment -

- · Blood CBC, ESR, BT, CT
- BSL a) Fasting and b) Post prandial
- · LFT
- · RFT
- Urine a) Routine and b) Microscopic
- · HBsAg
- · HIV I and II
- Digital rectal examination
- Proctoscopy

Criteria for Assessment -

The following pattern will be adopted for scoring.

- 1) PR bleeding
- 0- No bleeding.
- 1- Mild bleeding with defecation. (up to 10 drops)
- 2- Moderate bleeding. (10 to 20 drops)
- 3- Profuse bleeding. (more than 20 drops)
- 2) Pain For assessment of pain

Visual Analogue Scale (Mac' gills pain scale)
The following scale was used to help out assessing a severity of pain. Patients were asked to locate a finger any of the numerical over the scale and the severity pain was assessed according to that for which the r merical are labelled.

- 3) Size of Internal Haemorrhoid -
- 0-Complete Reduction.
- 1-Size Reduction by 25 %.
- 2-Size Reduction by 50%.
- 3-No Change in Size.

Assessment of effect of therapy (result) Cured -76% to 100 % relief in signs and symptoms. Markedly improved -51% to 75% relief in signs and symptoms

Improved –26% to 50% relief in signs and symptoms. Unchanged -upto 25% relief in sign and symptoms.

Observation and Results

Data obtained from observation of 10 pts, shows that, pain was relieved by an average of 85.71%, PR bleeding was relieved by 57.14% while 55.55% relief occurs in Size of Internal Haemorrhoid. This shows overall average of 65.21% relief in all symptoms which is highly significant.

Discussion - The clinical study done on 10 patients and its analysis shows marked improvement in symptoms like PR bleeding and significant decrease in size of Haemorrhoids, also about all patients got relieved from pain, and continued pregnancy without any complication.

Conclusion - The Bilva Patra Kwatha Avgahana Swedana is clinically proved as effective in treatment of Haemorrhoids in Garbhini and gives significant relief from all symptoms, proving it as safe, cost effective, standard, easy accessible treatment for internal Haemorrhoids in pregnancy without any untoward effect to mother and foetus.
