
Respected Sir,

For this event Dr. A.T. Vipra and Dr. Abhijit mane Patil worked as examiners.



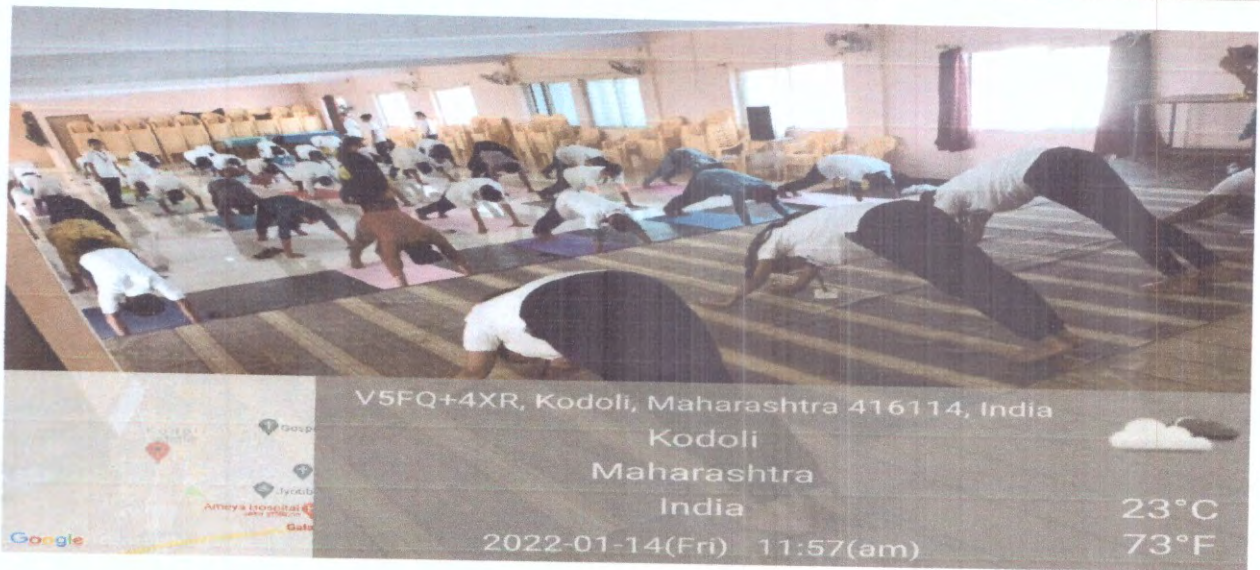
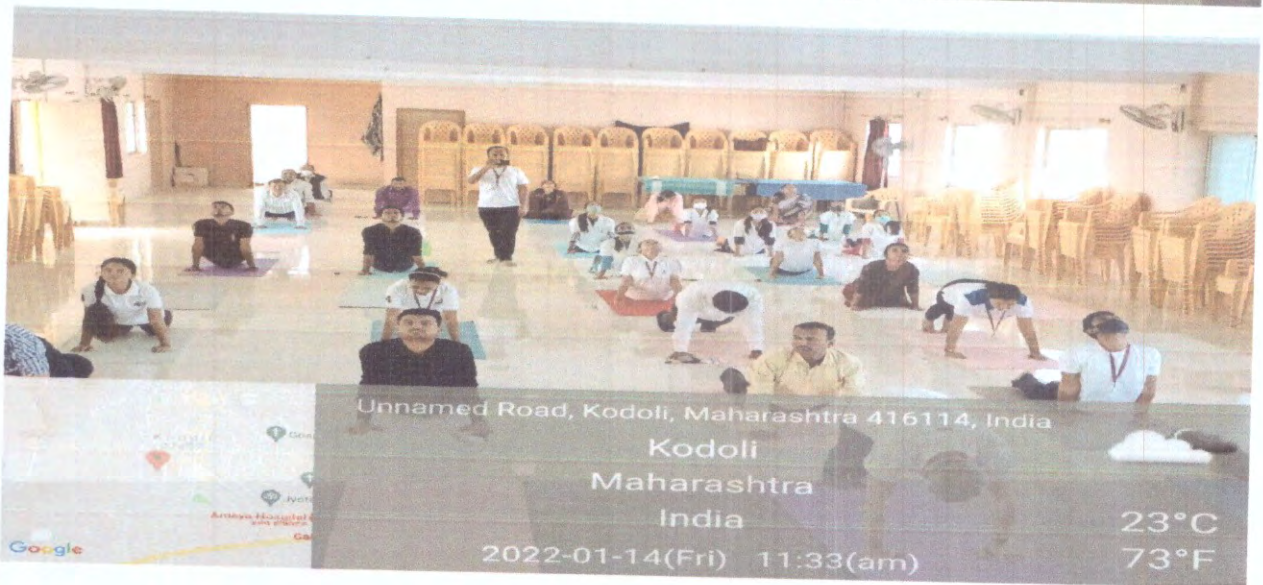
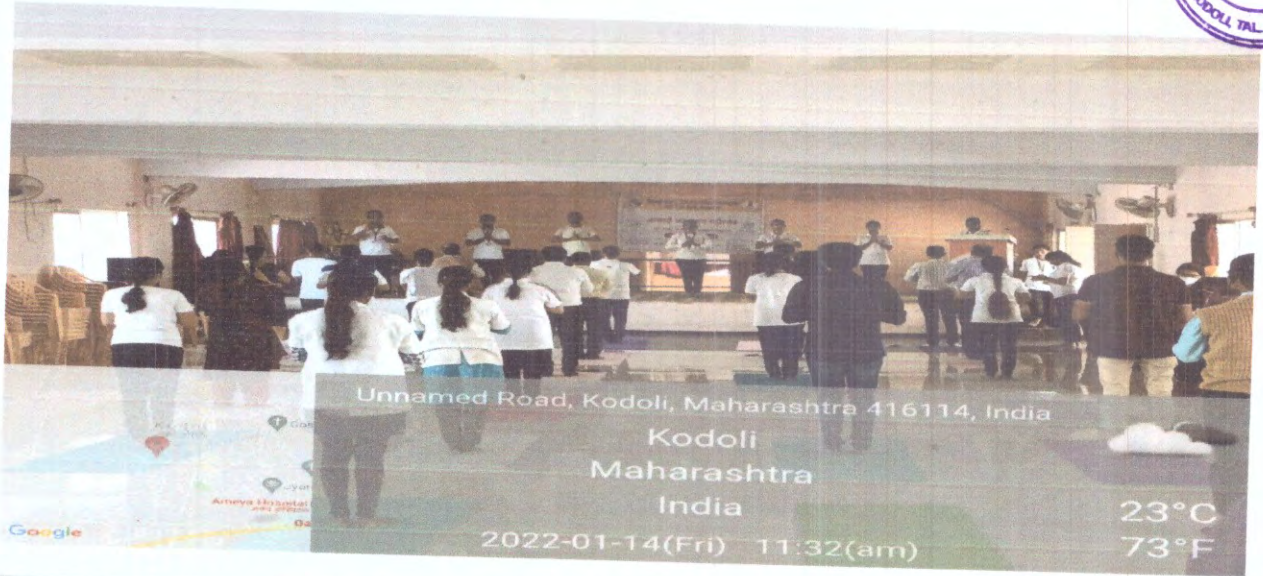
7. Celebration of “Vaishwik Suryanamaskar Pratykshik ”
